## ENCHANTED FOREST

It was early morning when filmmaker Craig Foster took this photo underwater in a kelp forest in Cape Point Nature Reserve. With him was ocean conservationist Ross Frylinck: 'The sun was low, the forest lit up and everything was radiant,' he says. 'Fish, sponges and anemones shone like living gems. I felt like an oceanaut floating through an alien world.' For years the two have been swimming the Cape's kelp forests while documenting their watery encounters; the result: Sea-Change, a multi-media project aimed at telling 'the story of humanity's origins on SA's coast' and promoting marine heritage. Catch it on Cape Town's Sea Point promenade as part of the annual Wavescape Festival this month, before it moves to Mossel Bay in May.
